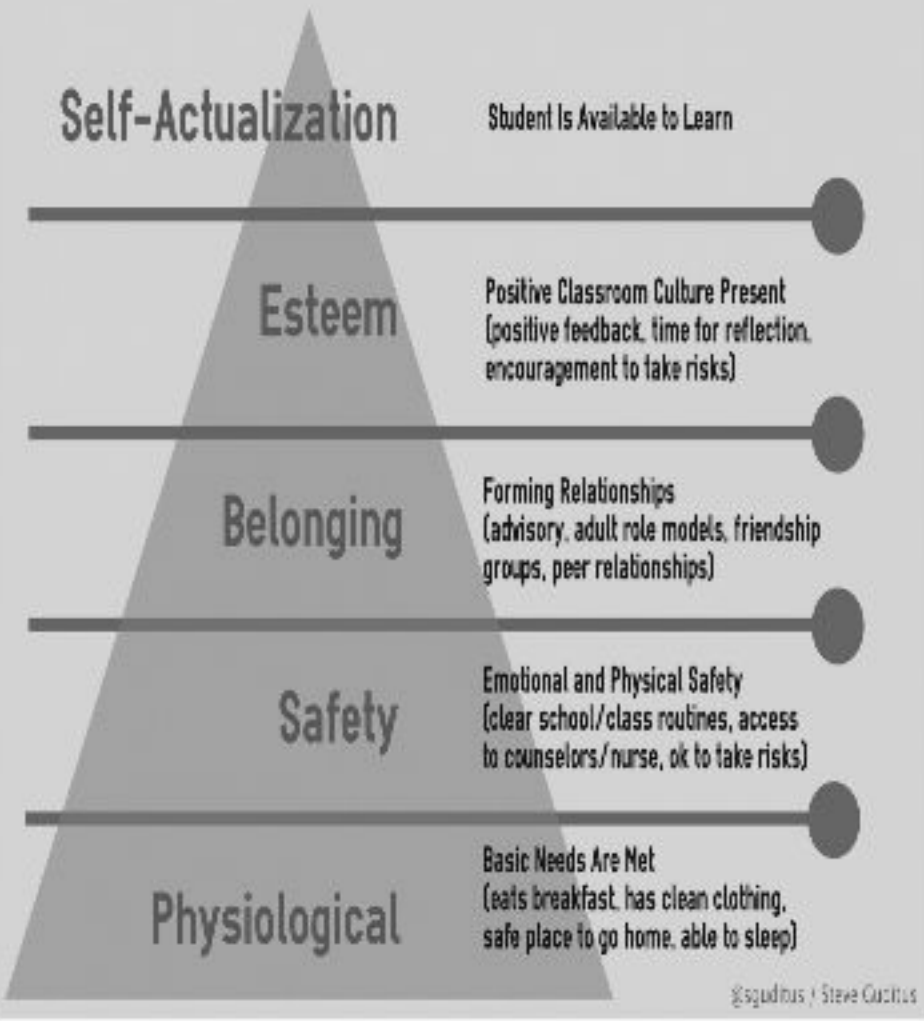


Maslow's Hierarchy of School Needs



From an educational standpoint, the basic premise of Maslow's Hierarchy of Needs is that students have foundational needs that must be met before meaningful learning can occur. Look at the table on the left and make sure you understand what's required at each level of need. On the right side detail what you are doing in your classroom to meet each need. Lastly, highlight the cell in the table that you believe the majority of your students and their families would say demonstrates the level at which their needs are being met consistently.
